"The Formula for Becoming Rich"

"For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ that though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich." II Corinthians 8:9

Before his incarnation as a baby in Bethlehem, Jesus enjoyed the riches of heaven with His Father. By becoming human—Paul says—he became poor. The intent of the incarnation of Jesus Christ was to impart God's riches through Jesus experience as a poor human being. The practical implication of Jesus birth in Bethlehem is that through Jesus we can enjoy the same riches reserved for the relationship between Jesus and His Father.

Paul began Chapter 8 of his second letter to the saints in Corinth by setting before them the example of the believers in Macedonia. In the midst of their material poverty these Macedonian churches expressed "rich generosity." In fact, Paul says, "they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing." So Paul uses this wonderful example of generosity for the needy in Jerusalem to encourage the Corinthian believers to also "excel in this grace of giving."

In a few short days, we have the blessed perspective of celebrating the beautiful story of the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem. It is a story about the rich and the poor. We have a Lord who loved each of us so much that He sent His Son from the rich confines of heaven to experience the poverty of the human experience. The real poverty in being human is not about the circumstances of Jesus' birth. So also, in Africa, being poor is not about living in a mud house with a thatched roof. Real poverty is in carrying the burden of sin. Jesus experienced exactly what it means to be really poor. He carried humanity's burden of sin. And he chose that poverty precisely so that we might enjoy the riches of God's presence.

Your gift changes lives:

- In 2012, 35 boys were rescued from the street and reunited with their families.
- In 2012, Capstone added two Bible study groups, bringing the number to 7 total.
- 350 children attended the World Weekend of Prayer hosted by Capstone on June 3,4
- 38 members of the 7 Bible study groups attended the joint gathering on July 12th.
- 20 boys attended Capstone Camp 2012 just last week. 8 were baptized. All are home and in school now.
- 15-25 boys who are still on the street are ministered to each Monday at the Youth Outreach on the Lutheran compound in Kisumu.
- More than 650 visits to families of reconciled boys were made in 2012.
 Families are encouraged with the Gospel, counseled, corrected and helped.
