Suggested Christmas Gifts

Reconciliation to God and Family: The vision of Capstone Ministries is a street child who is now a former street child and has been reunited with his family and knows the love of God in Christ Jesus. To date Capstone Ministries has reconciled more than 300 former street boys.



Christmas Gift Bag: Capstone selects the poorest of the poor to receive a bag of groceries. Although simple, this gift often allows a family to celebrate Christmas with a full meal that is seldom seen. Your gift of \$20 provides a Christmas meal for one

family

Secondary School Sponsorship --High School fees are often out of reach by the rural poor in Kenya. Capstone seeks sponsorship for achieving, needy boys who have finished Grade 8. Sponsorship for boys like Bennard on the right is \$600 per year for 4 years.



World Weekend of Prayer — More than 350 children from all the Lutheran congregations surrounding Kisumu gather for two days of games, teaching, prayer and worship. It is a two day event. The children sleep in nearby school classrooms. The children participate in the Sunday worship through prayer, dramas, poems, song and Scripture. Pastor Dan preaches and the parish pastor leads the liturgy. Sponsor this event in any amount. Total budget is \$750.
