We think that Isaiah & Berline have already shared the latest chapter in the rescue of Brian from last week, but just wanted to make sure you knew because it was such a glorious finish to what had been quite a tough week.

In fact, it feels like a trophy story that speaks of God bringing hope into a seemly hopeless situation and bringing a solution that is even better than we could have hoped for or imagined!

So, the story finishes very differently from how it had begun.

We had all believed that Brian's situation was that his sister wanted nothing to do with him, his grandmother could only offer a drunken and violent home, and his time in the KUOP just provided a strong pull and a further reason not to go 'home'!

Step 4 – Click on "Direct Choice Dollars" on the Thrivent Choice box on your MyThrivent page.

Step 5 – Search the catalog of organizations to find and select the "Capstone Ministries"

Step 6 – Click on "**Direct Choice Dollars Now**" to direct your designated Choice Dollars to benefit the reconciliation of street children with God and family! By phone:

Step 1 – Call **1-800-847-4836** and when prompted, say, "Thrivent Choice."

Step 2 – When prompted, say, "Choice Dollars."

Step 3 – Say or enter your Social Security number.

Step 4 – **Press 1** to direct Choice Dollars or **press 2** to hear the Thrivent Choice program terms and conditions.

Step 5 – A representative will then work with you to direct Choice Dollars for Capstone Ministries.

And in a meeting on Thursday after Johannes had reported on his pre-visit to Brian's grandmother, there was a real feeling of disappointment and discouragement about the future for Brian....however later on that day, a very different picture emerged.

The story unfolded (as Kenyan stories often do) and it transpired that when Brian's parents died (he was just 1 years old), the siblings were separated and handed over to different members of the family. Brian knew he had a sister and knew that she lived in Homa Bay but had never had any contact with her. Brian's sister however had been told that he was dead.

When on Thursday evening she heard the news that Brian was alive and well, but not in a good situation. her heart reaction was one of compassion and a desire for reconciliation. What is even more touching is that her husband was immediately offering to support Brian and provide a home and schooling for him!!!!!!

He welcomed him to his home with open arms! Isaiah's account of seeing this family reunited after so many years is touching and beautiful.

Brian is now with parents who are committed to him, in a home, getting enrolled into a local school and has a new brother and sister!

Wow! How absolutely awesome!

We both got teary and it is a great story to encourage us all that God can make a way where there seems to be no way.

Bless you both for pioneering Capstone and literally rescuing, saving and changing hundreds of boys lives, bringing hope to the hopeless and light into the darkness!

You guys rock and we salute you!!!!! Yay, Dan and Patty!

Also it was a real honor and privilege to watch the staff work together and support each other during this rescue. There was a real sense of unity and teamwork!

So cool!
